

Canada proposes that the OOXML specification include a specification of the following:

- All XML elements which appear in ISO29500 but do not appear in ECMA-376
- All XML attributes which appear in ISO29500 but do not appear in ECMA-376
- All enumeration values which appear in ISO29500 but do not appear in ECMA-376

Canada notes that this information would be of most utility to implementors if it could be made to appear inline in the spec, such that elements, attributes, and enumeration values which do not appear in ECMA-376 are so distinguished at the point where they are defined. However, it would be acceptable if they were enumerated in a non-normative appendix.

Canada believes that the Editor can assemble this information in a systematic way as changes to DIS29500 are processed, and thus the BRM need not assemble an explicit list.
